- Main conclusions:
- Education and non formal education is very important (some desagree)
- Roma responsability for rising awareness about Roma genocide
- Governments responsability education and knowledge is too low
- Important to work with other communities.

- - Important to link the past with the present
- More government support needed stop far right groups / Antigipsyism
- Recognition is very important
- - 2 histories: history of historians and history of people/practical history (collecting memory and identity)
